North of Bird Blind at Y-camp

June 5, 6, 7 Prothonotary warbler - Lower Ledges

June 6 - Cerulean warbler at creek junction, at the bottom of the paved hill, and at rest rooms near new rock shelter location lower Ledges.

June 15 - Yellow-bellied sapsucker drumming at swimming pool Y-camp.

June 25 - Cerulean warbler - deer enclosure @ upper Ledges.

June and July - Pair of Broad-winged hawks nesting North of T-intersection at Y-camp. 1 juvenile observed as recent as Aug. 4TH.
