Details on ibis, Jim Dinsmore

Species: White-faced Ibis Location: Dickinson county

Number: saw at least six, birds were flying around and dropping into rushes so couldn't see all at once

Date: 20 May, about 3 p.m., also saw them again next morning (21st)
Details: Birds were obviously a dark ibis; long legs, long decurved
bill clearly seen on numerous occasions. Plumage had an almost
purplish tinge to it in that hard-to-describe color of this species.
The birds would not perch where we had a clear view of them; flew and
then dropped into weeds where at most we could see head. I looked
repeatedly at the face and at the legs to check on colors. Not all of
the birds showed distinct White-face charactristics but did see them
on at least some of the birds. In flight, several times could see
that the red color was not confined to the ankles but also went up
onto the leg itself. Also could see distinct white color around the
base of the bill on one or two of the birds. On at least some of the
others this white was present but not very obvious. Both of these
characters plus the range clearly point to these birds being
white-faced ibis.
