Jim,

It appears that a loggerhead shrike is nesting at Doolittle prairie =  
(Plover tract). On June 19, 1999 I observed a shrike with food in its =  
mouth sitting in a mostly dead tree that had a nest in it about 10-15 feet =  
above the ground. I did not see the shrike go to the nest, but it stayed =  
in the tree even when I approached fairly close, and it was making a call =  
note the entire time. The tree in question is on the north border of the =  
prairie about a 1/3 of the way (between the NW & NE corners) from the NW =  
corner.=20
