Snowy Egret - 8

12 August 1984

Missouri River floodplain just south of the ~~Mississippi~~ Bridge
to Nebraska City; Fremont County

Description: White herons, feeding actively in shallow water.
Bills black, Base of bill or bare skin of face yellow. Feet
bright yellow. Legs black in front + greenish behind.

Similar species: The black bill eliminates Great Egret +
Cattle Egret. Immature Little Blue Herons have uniformly
colored legs. Both Great Egrets + Little Blues were present + they
were not feeding actively like the Snowys - not running around, that is

Viewing conditions: the herons were on the other side of a
flooded field, rather far. 100 yds? I really don't know.
Mid afternoon, looking east with a 20x scope. I watched
a long time, until I was sure of them, + they were there when
I left. No books. Nobody else was there, but I called a
rare bird alert at Omaha and ~~the~~ several others saw
these birds over the next few ~~ye~~ days.
