Snowy Egret

On August 12, 1984 we saw 5 immatures in a flooded field in south Fremont Co. south of Hwy 2. They were approximately half the size of a great egret that was near by. The legs were dark in front, yellowish in back, with yellow feet. The bill was black with a yellow cere. They were running and jumping in the water, and were spreading their wings while feeding. We viewed them from a distance of about 150 yards while using a 25x Bushnell spotting scope.
