This morning, June 27th, at 8:30 A.M. and again at 10:45 A.M. I observed 2 adult and 2 young Sandhill Cranes. The location was in the northeastern most corner of Allamakee County, about 1/2 mile south of the HWY 26 bridge over the Upper Iowa River. The location is known locally as Bakewell's Pond (which has consistently supported a nice population of Yellow-headed Blackbirds). The 4 cranes were feeding in knee high corn about 500 feet east of the highway/railroad tracks, on the north side of the pond. I have observed 2 adult cranes in this same area irregularly since about mid April.

This particular site will be featured in the upcoming Mississippi River Birding Trail publication/map, which a number of birders have been working on.
