Had a big flight of passerines through central Iowa 13-14 Sept. Overcast night and had big kill at Alleman TV Tower. JS, JD and Rochelle Renken picked up 384 birds of 33 species (plus 1 Empidonax) including 17 species of warblers. Far and away, major species was Red-eyed Vireo (133), next ~~was~~ were Swainson's Thrush (33) and ✓ Ovenbird (32). A much smaller kill occurred next night (35 birds).
