Vellow-bellied Flycatcher -- At least 3 responded to taped calls at St. Lucas May 22. ~ Black-throated Blue Warbler -- One singing male at St. Lucas May 18. - Lark Sparrow -- Two singing males at Vinton, May 10 - Sharp-shinned Hawk and Cooper's Hawk --Of 25+ accipiter species recorded at sweet Marsh, Bremer County, 3 were positively recorded Cooper's, the rest were likely all sharp-shinned. <u>Red-shouldered Hawk</u>-- One at Uinton, Benton County, May 10. - <u>Swainson's Hawk-- A pair</u> was at Waucoma, Fayatla County, in second half of May, probably nesting here as in years past. Common Bobowhite--Common only in Volga Lake, Fayette County, otherwise sporadic.
