Brief Field Notes from Lamoni —

Killdeer - abundant nesting in cultivated fields
(5 or 6 pairs on 160 acres)

Upland sandpiper - scarce. I do not see them every day. In previous years I have seen them every day during summer.

Horned Lark - abundant in cultivated fields nesting

Yellow-headed blackbird - a small flock seen
mid April by Leslie Barnett.

Bobolink - 8 to 10 pairs nesting in 100 acre pasture
across road from my house.

Grasshopper sparrow - I hear several singing, males
in same pasture.

Dickcissel - ~~can~~ have seen around farthest meadow
