Dear Tom,

Here is my Spring Report. Not too much to report. Most species arrived and departed on schedule and the numbers were about the same as last year.

- Ruby-thr. Hummingbird: Sightings were up.
- ✓ Purple Martin: First seen April 2, and they seem to be in good numbers.
 - Eastern Bluebird: Still no sign of recovery from 77-78, 78-79 bad Winters. Sightings the same as last year.
 - Red-eyed Vireos: Few more than last Spring.
 - Warbling Vireos: Few more than last Spring.
 - Golden-winged Warbler: Seen May 8 and 9.
 - Lark Sparrow: A few more seen this Spring.
 - ✓ Double-crested Cormorants: 33 seen on 4/12, 35 seen on 5/11. Most I've seen here.
 - Green Heron: Numbers up.
 - ✓ Cooper's Hawk: Seen March 30.
 - American Kestrel: Sighting way down, only 10 to 15 seen on a days outing, compared to 31 to 40 last Spring.
 - ✓ Bobwhite Quail: Numbers up from last Spring.
