REVISED FROM NORTHWEST IOWA, MAINLY CHEROKEE CO.

REVIEWED TO AT NOZ (REVIEWED AND REVISED)

CUCKOOS - number of both species seem to be normal.

WHIP-OR-WILL - singles heard singing on June 8th and July 24th, both in different locations along the Little Sioux River in Cherokee Co. UNKNOWN - JETZER

Common Nighthawk - few seen.

BELTED KINGFISHER - I feel their numbers

may be up slightly from last year.

WOODPECKERS - ALL doing well.

EASTERN KINGBIRD - IN my SPRING NOTES I

SAYED THEIR NUMBERS MAY BE DOWN. I WISH

TO RETRACT THAT AS THEY ARE VERY COMMON

now. (in behavior I prob. TRUSTED IT)

BLUEBIRD - I HAD MORE NEST BOXES OCCUPIED

THAN ANY YEAR PREVIOUS. I HAD 23 SUCCESSFUL NESTINGS.

HOODED MERAINTER - 1 Female JUNE 2ND, IN
PLYMOUTH COUNTY, IOWA - BIG SIOUX RIVER
OVERFLOW POND, 45 PLAT 64

KESTREL - uncommon but nesting in
WEST IOWA.

PHEASANT - EXCELLENT numbers

UPLAND SANDPIPER - ON July 25 I observed
AN ADULT [REDACTED] AND AN IMMATURE, [REDACTED]
ON A GRAVEL ROAD 1½ miles west of THE 130 ACRE
STEELE PRAIRIE. I CAPTURED THE YOUNG TO
GET A CLOSE EXAMINATION. IT WAS TOO YOUNG TO
FLY BUT COULD RUN QUITE FAST. THE ADULT WAS
NATURALLY UPSET SO I RELEASED THE YOUNG AND
LEFT. THE NEXT DAY I RETURNED AND OBSERVED
BOTH AGAIN. THIS IS A NESTING RECORD IN CHEROKEE
COUNTY FORMERLY. I FEEL THE NEARBY PRAIRIE
HABITAT WAS PROBABLY THE FACTOR FOR THEIR NEST
IN THE AREA.

FRANKLINS GULL JUNE 29th I observed 2
FRANKLIN GULLS RESTING AT THE CHEROKEE
SEWAGE LAGOONS.
