Iowa birds - 1 June - 31 July, 1980

Broad-winged Hawk - 1 adult-plumaged bird seen flying along Cedar River, Palisades Kepler State Park, Linn Co., on 8 June.

American Kestrel: only one seen during period, an adult male 2 mi south of Swan Lake, Johnson Co., on 17 July.

Shorebirds: Rather large numbers of early shorebirds were observed at Cone Marsh, Louisa Co., on 13 and 14 July. Totals for 13 July are given and the 14 July numbers were similar. 18 July numbers, showing the great influx of Pectoral sandpipers, are given also.

Upland Sandpiper: Two birds, seen at the same time, in field in Lincoln Township, Johnson Co. on 28 May.

Stilt Sandpiper: 1 at Cone Marsh July 13, 14.
3 on Coralville Reservoir, north of Greencastle cover, on 17 July.

Ruby-throated Hummingbird: none seen during period

Acadian Flycatcher - At least one singing bird seen at Wildcat Den State Park, Muscatine Co., on 6 and 14 June.

Veery: one heard in Hickory Hill Park, Iowa City, on 31 May.

Eastern Bluebird: none seen during period.

Loggerhead Shrike - one seen on 16 June 2 miles south of the population near the Lincoln Township meeting hall (Johnson County).

Bell's Vireo:

The Hickory Hill Park, Iowa City, population included at least four different singing males during June.

Five birds were heard singing at different Cone Marsh locations on 18 July.

Blue-winged warbler - one heard at Lake McBride Field Campus of U. of Iowa, Johnson Co., on June 1.
- one heard and seen near Cou Falls area of Johnson Co. on 4 June.

Cerulean Warbler - Two different birds seen and heard at Wildcat Den State Park on June 6.
The Palisades Kepler State Park population could not be found on 8 June.

Yellow-throated Warbler - one heard and seen ~~along river near picnic area of Wildcat Den State Park on June 6.~~ A second bird, singing a song nearly identical to the first, was heard in the Devil's Punchbowl area on same date.

- one heard and seen again along river at Wildcat Den on 14 June.

Louisiana Waterthrush - one seen (and heard briefly) in Devil's Punchbowl area of Wildcat Den S.P. on 6 June.

Kentucky Warbler - At least 2 different singing birds were seen and heard at Wildcat Den S.P. on 6 June. On 14 June one bird was seen.
