Summer, 1995 Report from Jane R. Clark

June 4, 1995 at Brown's Woods in West Des Moines:

Summer Tanager, male singing and sighted.

Cerulean Warbler, singing and sighted.

Several Yellow-billed Cuckoos, singing.

These birds were sighted by Jane Clark, Sue Spieker, and Bery Engebretson.

June 5, 1995 at Holst Forest north of Boone:

Canada Warbler, identified by the spectacles, gray back, and necklace, feeding about 5 feet off the ground.

I was with Maridel and she saw a bird she thought was a Kentucky, but the bird I saw had a necklace.

Several Oven Birds singing.

June, 1995 at American Republic Insurance at 6th and Keosauqua in Des Moines:

Peregrine Falcons fledged three young, I believe all female, in the southeast corner of the top floor. About 2-3 weeks earlier than last year.
