I have two unusual bird observations to include in my annual report to your department at the close of this year. One of them is the observation of Arkansas Kingbirds here on two different days last May - two the first day and four the next following day. Kindly advise if you have any records from Iowa showing this bird as far east as central Iowa where we are located.

My other interesting report is that the Woodcock are nesting in the Ledges State Park in this County. To the best of my knowledge this bird has not nested here for many years and I would be pleased to know of any records that you may have of this bird nesting here in recent years. Kindly advise.

About two months ago I ordered an additional supply of Form Bi-801 cards but have never received them. Please send me about 100 more cards as I need them for my report. My list this year will be the largest I have ever sent you and I hope to add a few more this fall.
