

IN NEW REPORTS, AT WALTON LAKE JUST EAST OF FAIRFIELD IN JEFFERSON CO, COMMON MOONHEN AND LEAST BITTERS ON THE 23<sup>RD</sup> AND AT SWAN LAKE SOUTH OF THE CONRADVILLE RESERVOIR IN JOHNSON COUNTY, DUNLIN, STATE SANDPIPER, WILSON'S PHALAROPE & WESTERN SANDPIPER ON THE 27<sup>TH</sup>.

AND THE WESTERN KINGBIRDS HAVE RETURNED TO THE AREA JUST EAST OF DES MOINES WHERE THEY HAVE NESTED AT LEAST THE PAST 5 YEARS. TO LOOK FOR THEM, FROM HIGHWAY 163, GO NORTH ON 70<sup>TH</sup> ST NE 1 MILE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH 12<sup>TH</sup> AVE NE. LOOK AROUND THAT INTERSECTION.

THIS HAS BEEN A SPRING FOR CINNAMON TEAL IN THE STATE AND NORTHWEST IOWA IS THE LATEST LOCATION. ON MAY 19, A DRAKE CINNAMON TEAL, ALONG WITH A FEMALE TEAL SPECIES WERE SEEN AT LILAN'S MARSH 3 1/2 MILES NORTHWEST OF ELMA IN HOWARD COUNTY. TO LOOK FOR THE TEAL DRIVE AS FAR NORTH AS YOU CAN ALONG THE EAST SIDE, THEN WALK A PATH NORTH TO THE NORTH END AND LOOK WEST. THE BIRDS WERE STILL PRESENT ON THE 21<sup>ST</sup>. AT THE IOWA SPRING MEETING AT DAVENPORT ~~WAS~~ CONCLUDED ON SUNDAY THE 21<sup>ST</sup> AND THE FIELD TRIPS NETTED A TOTAL OF 172 SPECIES WITH OVER 20 WARBLERS. ON ONE OF THE FIELD TRIPS AT PRINCETON MARSH NORTH OF PRINCETON UP TO 5 COMMON MORNING, SOME IN COURTSHIP BEHAVIOR, YELLOW HEADED BLACKBIRDS, AND A KING RAIL IN BREEDING PLUMAGE ALONG THE WEST SIDE. OTHER GOOD BIRDS FROM THE IOWA WEEKEND INCLUDED HOODED MERGANSER, SANDHILL CRANE, AND WILSON'S PHALAROPE.
