

IN A NEW REPORT, A BLACK-SHOULDERED KITE  
WAS OBSERVED AT 1 OTTER CREEK MARSH IN TAMA  
COUNTY ON MONDAY AFTERNOON SEPT 16. IT WAS  
SEEN FLYING OVER THE MARSH FOR 4-5 MINUTES, DID  
NOT LAND + COULD NOT BE RELOCATED.

AT THE TOW FALL MEETING AT SPIRIT LAKE OVER  
THE PAST WEEKEND, OVER 140 SPECIES WERE COUNTED  
DURING THE 2 DAYS, INCLUDING RED NECKED PHALAROPE  
AT UNTAN SLough MNR IN KELLOGG COUNTY AND ALSO  
AT LAKE OKABEJI. ALSO MANY FRANKLIN'S GULLS,  
AND WHITE PELICANS.

IN SOUTHEAST IOWA, FIRST DISCOVERED <sup>on Sept 9</sup>  
THE HARRIS' HAWK, IN BENTON COUNTY WAS LAST RE-  
PORTED ON THURSDAY Sept 14. <sup>IT WAS NOT TO</sup> ~~IT WAS~~ <sup>TO</sup> ~~IT WAS~~ SEEN,  
EVEN THOUGH IT WAS SEARCHED FOR ON SEPT 16+17.  
IT'S LOCATION WAS AROUND A BARE FEEDLOT ON  
THE EAST SIDE OF BENTON COUNTY ROAD V-56, ABOUT  
2 1/2 MILES SOUTH OF BLAIRSTOWN. IT HAS PERCHED ON FENCE-  
POLES, UTILITY POLES, AND DEAD TREES (SPECIALLY A LOW  
DEAD TREE ON TOP OF THE HILL EAST OF THE FEEDLOT)

10 MILES NORTH OF BURLINGTON AROUND A MISSISSIPPI RIVER SANDBAR  
(A NUMBER GOOD BIRDS LAST WEEK INCLUDING JUVENILE  
LONGAWL GULL, SNOWY EAGLET, NEARLY GULL COMMON, CASHMAD  
FORSTER'S + BLACK TERNS, PELICAN, SANDBRANE, <sup>AN</sup> OSPREY, AND UP TO 200  
MIGRANT EGRETS. <sup>FOR MORE INFORMATION, CALL CHUCK</sup>

HERONS WENT OVER ON THE 10TH AND SEVERAL BIRDS HAVE ROOSTED <sup>IN A GROVE OF</sup> ~~EAST~~ THE PARK  
IN CENTRAL IOWA AT THE SAYLORVILLE RESERVOIR  
IN POLK COUNTY AT THE SANDPIPER REC AREA  
BLACK CROWNED NIGHT HERON, COMMON, CASHMAD + FOOTTED!
