IN MASON COUNTY, A BLACK SCOTER AT ROBERTS CREEK LAKE,
A TAYLOR'S GULL AT THE NORTH OVERLOOK BEACH AND THE
CONTINUED PRESENCE OF THE LESSER BLACK-BACKED GULL IN FIRST
WINTER PLUMAGE BELOW THE DAM

WATERFOWL MIGRATION IS REALLY IN FULL SWING
NOW AS DUCKS AND GEESE HELD UP NORTH BY
THE INDIAN SUMMER POOL INTO THE STATE. THE
BEST BIRD, HOWEVER, IS ^{THE FIRST STATE RECORD FOR} THE COMMON BLACK-HEADED
^{AN ADULT IN WINTER PLUMAGE} GULL, FIRST DISCOVERED AT SANDORVILLE RESERVOIR
NORTH OF DES MOINES ON NOV. 2. IT WAS SEEN AGAIN
ON SATURDAY THE 4TH FLYING OVER THE DAM AND
THE PONDS BELOW THE DAM AT MIDDAY. IT WAS
NOT SEEN ON SUNDAY THE 5TH. ALSO AT SANDORVILLE
ON THE 5TH, 5 BLACK SCOTERS, HORNED AND WESTERN
GREBES, COMMON LOONS, AND NUMEROUS DUCKS AND
GULLS, MOST OF WHICH WERE SEEN FROM THE DAM,
AND AT SANDPIPER, A SNOW BUNTING ON THE 4TH,
AND A PRARIE FALCON AT THE DAM ON THE 3RD.
AT BIG CREEK STATE PARK, AN OLD SEAGULL ON THE 5TH.

IN SOUTHWEST IOWA AT THE IPL GENERATING
STATION SOUTH OF COUNCIL BLUFFS, ON NOV 5TH,
IN THE SOUTH POND A PACIFIC LOON AND WHITE-WINGED
SCOTER AND IN THE NORTH POND, A FIRST YEAR
GLAUCOUS GULL AND 2 OLD SEAGULLS. IN HARRISON
COUNTY AT SAWMILL HOLLOW A RED NECKED
GREBE AND AT DE SOTO NWR 5 ROLL GEESE
WERE PICKED OUT OF THE ESTIMATED 10,000 SNOW
GEESE

IN NORTHWEST IOWA, 200 SNOW GEESE AT MIND LAKE
IN CLAY COUNTY, ^{AND} BIRD EAGLES IN PALO ALTO AND CLAY
COUNTIES, ^{ALSO IN CLAY COUNTY,} A VORICED THRASHA ON THE EAST SIDE OF TRAM-

BULL LAKE IN CLAY COUNTY, 5 LONG EARED OWLS, NEAR
DENNEY'S PASTURE, AND A RED-SHAPED FLICKER 10
MILES SOUTH OF SPENCER, ALL ON THE 4TH

IN SOUTH CENTRAL IOWA ON THE 5TH 72 TOTAL
SPECIES WERE SEEN AT RATHBUN RESERVOIR,
INCLUDING LARGE NUMBERS OF COMMON LOONS AND HOODED
GREBE, SNOW AND CANADA GEESE, 10 HARRIERS,
2 BLACK BELLED PLOVERS, A PUNLIN, AND A SNOW
BUNTING.

IN SOUTHEAST IOWA AT THE NORTH ARM OF LAKE
MACBRIDE IN JOHNSON COUNTY, HOODED AND RED
BREASTED MERGANSERS, HORNED GREBE AND WOODCOCK
AND 3 OSPREY AT THE CORNWALL RESERVOIR DAM
ON THE 7TH. AT LAKE OVEDA, LOUISA COUNTY,
1200 CANADA, AND 250 SNOW GEESE ON THE 2ND
AND AT CEDAR LAKE IN CEDAR RAPIDS A HORNED
GREBE ON THE 6TH.

IN NEW REPORTS FROM THE 8TH, 12 HORNED
GREBES AT CEDAR LAKE IN CEDAR RAPIDS AND
THE WHITE-WINGED SCOTER WAS STILL ON THE SANTA
POND AT THE IPL GENERATING STATION SOUTH OF
COUNCIL BLUFFS.
