The SCISSOR-TAILED FLYCATCHER seen in a field in a new housing development north of Iowa City on the 5th was never relocated. Elsewhere in the southeast, at and near the Croton Unit of Shimek State Forest the BEWICK'S WREN was back singing at the junkyard location, and there were other good sightings on the 9th. In Lee County, from the stop sign in the village of Argyle, go west two miles and then right at a Y. The junkyard is 0.3 miles on both sides of the road. Another quarter mile along the road, a SUMMER Tanager was found. At the usual location, into the woods from the small parking lot which is 1.3 miles from the Y, CERULEAN and BLUE-WINGED WARBLERS, NORTHERN PARULA, YELLOW BREASTED CHAT, WHITE-EYED VIREO, CAROLINA WREN, ACADIAN FLYCATCHER, SCARLET Tanager, and both BLACK-BILLED and YELLOW-BILLED CUCKOOS. In Burlington, two BLACK CROWNED NIGHT HERONS were seen flying by MacArthur Bridge over the Mississippi on the 9th.

In the central part of the state, Margaret Brooke reports a CAROLINA WREN singing at 3306 Elmwood Drive in Des Moines on the 9th. A NORTHERN HARRIER was in Franklin County over a large CRP field 3 and a half miles east of I-35 along county road C-55 on the 5th. At Holst Forest in Boone County, a CHESTNUT-SIDED WARBLER and four VEERIES were present on the 5th.

In the northwest at Union Slough NWR in Kossuth County, a WESTERN GREBE was observed on the 7th.

In the northeast, an interesting report of a OSPREY catching fish in a natural pond northwest of Mt. Vernon in Linn County on the 8th.
