

A NUMBER OF NEW REPORTS AND UPDATES OF PREVIOUSLY REPORTED BIRDS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED

IN NW IOWA IN BUREAU COUNTY (O JUST N. OF STORM LAKE A GREAT TAILED GRACKLE WAS SEEN ALONG COUNTY ROAD C-49 WITHIN THE FIRST MILE EAST OF US HIGHWAY 71 ON THE 26TH.

IN GRUNDY COUNTY A SNOWY OWL HAS BEEN SEEN 3 TIMES THE LAST ON JAN 24TH. TO LOOK FOR THIS BIRD
MILES N OF GRUNDY CENTER AT THE JCT OF HWY'S #14 AND US 20 ~~7 MILES EAST~~
~~OF GRUNDY CENTER~~ GO WEST 1 MILE ON THE GRAVEL AND SEARCH THIS AREA.

ON THE 26TH; IN HARVEST PINE SISKINS & RED BREASTED NUTHATCH IN THE IOWA FALLS CEMETERY NEAR ELMWOOD COLLEGE ON THE 27TH. AT SAVORYVILLE RESERVOIR IN POLK CO., A RED SHOULDERS HAWK S. OF POLK CITY ALONG HIGHWAY 415 ON THE 27TH, 3 GLASSY WINGS ON THE 27TH, 2 FRANKLIN'S GULLS ON THE 21ST, AND AN IMMATURE SANDHILL CRANE WEST OF BIG CREEK ON THE 21ST. AND AT THE ENTRANCE TO SANDPIPER REC. AREA, 2 SHORT & 2 LONG EARED OWLS IN CEDARS ON THE 22ND.

IN DES MOINES, 2 WHITE WINGED CROSSBILLS HAVE BEEN SEEN IN GLENDALE CEMETERY, ON THE 23RD, 2 TRUMPETER SWANS ^{still} DOWN STREAM FROM THE SE 14TH ST BRIDGE, AND A WINTER WREN AT 9871 LINCOLN IN WINDSOR HEIGHTS. THE VARIED THRUSH WAS SEEN ON THE 22ND IN THE DAY YARD WHERE IT HAS BEEN FOR 2 MONTHS. FOR DIRECTIONS LEAVE YOUR NAME & PHONE # AFTER THIS REPORT

HARVEY LAST WEEK HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED BY ITS
