~~HIGHLIGHTS THIS WEEK ARE 2 CINNAMON
TEAL AND 2 GOLDEN EAGLE REPORTS.~~

~~In SE Iowa, AT THE CORNWALL RESERVOIR
Jefferson County, an immature Golden Eagle was
seen from the end of the Babcock Lake Road on
APRIL 15TH. This area is reached by exiting
Highway 965 2 miles north of North Liberty, and
going west on the gravel 3 3/4 miles, then north on
the B.K. Road (which is sand) a little over a mile
to where it ends at a parking lot. There are
also up to 6 Short-eared Owls ^{I LONG AGO SAW} and several
HARRIERS in the same area. Also at the Cornuelle
Res. 70 species seen on the 15th including 14
ducks, purple martins & various rumped warbler. And
on the 11th great egrets and white pelicans and
on the 16th Caspian Terns at the snowy Beach area.~~

~~Also in SE Iowa at Cove Marsh in Linn
County, a drake Cinnamon Teal was seen most of
last week & last reported on the 14th
most likely water south of the South Road.
On the 14th Lesser Scaups flying over Cove Marsh
near Fairfield in Jefferson County, Broad
winged Hawk and 4 gold rumped warbler and
Lake Darling S.P. "Bonaparte's" birds all on the
15th and north of Burlington a dozens water
birds on the 15th. And a 10 m. down hill on the
17th. At Lacey Rd S.P. in Van Buren 16 ^{yellow-throats} waterbirds
on the 15th~~

EAST OF UNION IN HARDIN COUNTY ON THE
14TH, AND 2 MARLED GODWITS EAST OF UNION ON
THE 10TH. ALSO IN HARDIN COUNTY AT PINE LAKE
SP. ON THE 16TH A SWAINSON'S HAWK,
1 3 GREATER SCAUP, BLACK CROWNED
NIGHT HERON AND WINTER WREN.

AT BIG CREEK SP, THE MALE CINNAMON TEAL
FIRST FOUND ON THE 13TH WAS STILL PRESENT ON
THE 29TH. TO LOOK FOR THIS BIRD NW OF POLK CITY,
GO EAST FROM HIGHWAY 445 ON A DEAD END ROAD
BY A SMALL CHURCH (146TH ST) AT THE T, GO
NORTH & AT THE END OF THE ROAD SURVEY THE MARSH
FOR THE TEAL. OR GO IN THE EAST SIDE OF LAKE TO THE WESTERN
PIPELS AT THE BEACH AND 2 WHITE-WINGED
SNIKERS ON THE 19TH

THE NORTH END OF
AT SAVILOVILLE RESERVOIR IN THE TESLER PARK AREA,
AN AMERICAN BITTERN ON THE 15TH AND AT LITTLE
MAN LAKE IN HAMILTON COUNTY 4 HORNS GREEN
AND AT A BOONE COUNTY MARSH, YELLOW NECKED
BLACKBIRDS.

IN NE IOWA AT CEDAR LAKE IN CEDAR RAPIDS, A
HORNED LARK ON THE 14TH AND BONAPARTE'S LIM. ON THE 14TH
AND A BROWN CRESCENT AT READING ON THE 20TH

IN NW IOWA AT SPENCER IN CLAY COUNTY A COMMON
