~~IN SE TOWNSHIP, AT THE CORALVILLE RESERVOIR IN  
JEFFERSON COUNTY, AN IMMATURE GOLDEN EAGLE WAS  
SEEN FROM THE END OF THE BARBOCK LAKE ROAD ON  
APRIL 15TH. THIS AREA IS REACHED BY EXITING  
HIGHWAY 965 2 MILES NORTH OF NORTH LIBERTY, AND  
GOING WEST ON THE GRAVEL 3 3/4 MILES, THEN NORTH ON  
THE B.V. ROAD (WHICH IS SAND) A LITTLE OVER A MILE  
TO WHERE IT ENDS AT A PARKING LOT. THERE ARE  
ALSO UP TO 6 SHORT-GRASS <sup>1 LONG-GRASS PLOT</sup> AND SEVERAL  
NARRIERS IN THE SAME AREA. <sup>ON THE 20TH A</sup> ALSO AT THE CORALVILLE  
RES. 70 SPECIES SEEN ON THE 15TH INCLUDING 14  
DUCKS, PURPLE MARTIN & YELLOW RUMPED WARBLER. AND  
ON THE 11TH GREAT EGRET AND WHITE PELICAN AND  
ON THE 16TH CASPIAN TERN AT THE SANDY BEACH AREA.~~

~~ALSO IN SE TOWNSHIP AT CONE MARSH IN LANSING  
COUNTY, A <sup>DRAKE</sup> CINNAMON TEAL WAS SEEN MOST OF  
LAST WEEK <sup>& LAST REPORTED ON THE 14TH</sup> WITH BLUE WING TEAL IN THE  
MOST WESTERLY WATER SOUTH OF THE SOUTH ROAD.  
AND ON THE 14TH LESSER GOLDEN PLOVERS FLYING OVER CONE MARSH.  
NEAR FAIRFIELD IN JEFFERSON COUNTY TOWNSHIP, BROAD  
WINGED HAWK AND YELLOW RUMPED WARBLER AND  
LAKE DARLING S.P. <sup>WASHINGTON COUNTY</sup> BONAPARTE'S GULL ALL ON THE  
15TH AND NORTH OF BURLINGTON A DOZEN WATER  
PIPITS ON THE 15TH. AND A HUMMINGBIRD ON THE  
17TH. AT LACEY-KEO SP IN VAN BUREN <sup>YELLOW STAR WING</sup> 10+ LA WATERHENS

GO EAST FROM HIGHWAY 45 ON A DEAD END ROAD  
BY A SMALL CHURCH (146<sup>TH</sup> ST) AT THE T, GO  
NORTH AT THE END OF THE ROAD SURVEY THE MARSH  
FOR THE TEAL. <sup>OR GO IN THE EAST SIDE OF LAKE TO THE MARSH</sup> ALSO AT BIG CREEK, 14 BAYARDS SAND-  
PIPERS AT THE BEACH AND A 2 WHITE-WINGED  
SLOTS ON THE 19<sup>TH</sup>

THE NORTH END OF  
AT Saylorville Reservoir in the Jester Park area,  
AN AMERICAN BITTERN ON THE 15<sup>TH</sup> AND AT LITTLE  
WAN LAKE IN RAMAPO COUNTY 4 HORNED GREES  
AND AT A BOONE COUNTY MARSH, YELLOW NEADED  
BLACKBIRDS.
