SEEN IN POWESHIEK COUNTY ON THE 20<sup>TH</sup>  
APPROXIMATELY 3 MILES EAST AND A 1/2 MILE  
SOUTH OF THE <sup>GRINWELL</sup> I-80 INTERCHANGE. AT THE RAINBOW  
OVERLOOK OF RED ROCK IN MILK COUNTY A GOSSAWK ON  
THE 14<sup>TH</sup>

AT LAKE KEOMAH EAST OF OSKALOUSA IN MA-  
HASKA COUNTY, 5 TRUMPETER SWANS (1 MALE  
AND 4 CUBNETS) HAVE BEEN PRESENT FOR
