In Southwest Iowa on the 28TH AT THE IOWA
POWER & LIGHT CO. PLANT SOUTH OF COUNCIL BLUFFS
IN MILLS COUNTY, 4 LEAST TERN AND A PIPING
PLOVER AND ABOUT A HALF MILE NE OF THE
POWER PLANT WESTERN KINGBIRDS AND BLUE
GROSBEAKS

In Central Iowa, THE WESTERN KINGBIRDS HAVE
RETURNED TO THE AREA JUST EAST OF DES MOINES
WHERE THEY HAVE NESTED AT LEAST THE PAST 5
YEARS. TO LOOK FOR THEM, FROM HIGHWAY #163, GO
NORTH ON 70TH ST NE .1 MILE TO THE IN-
TERSECTION WITH 12TH AVE NE. LOOK AROUND THAT
INTERSECTION.

In Southeast Iowa at Swan Lake in Johnson
County, DUNLIN, STILT SANDPIPER, WILSON'S PHAL-
LOPHE AND WESTERN SANDPIPER ON THE 27TH. AT
OR NEAR LIVINGSTON TIMBER NORTH OF FAIRFIELD IN
JEFFERSON COUNTY, BLACK-BELLIED CUCKOO, OLIVE-SIDED
FLYCATCHER AND ORCHARD ORIOLE, ON THE 28TH. IN
DES MOINES COUNTY SOUTH OF BURLINGTON A YELLOW
CROWNED NIGHT HERON AND PROTHONOTARY WARBLERS
NEAR THE ISA GENERATING PLANT, AND NORTH OF
BURLINGTON FORSTER TERNS, ALL ON THE 29TH. IN
LEE COUNTY, FRANKLIN'S GANNET BLACK TERNS
SEEN FROM THE LINCOLN LONGER REST AREA ON HIGHWAY
#61 JUST NORTH OF MONROE ON THE 29TH.
