IN SOUTHWEST IOWA, AT LAKE ANITA STATE PARK SOUTH OF ANITA IN CASS COUNTY 2 MOUNTAIN BLUE-BIRDS WERE STILL PRESENT MARCH 24TH. THIS IS FROM A FLOCK OF UP TO 20 BIRDS FIRST OBSERVED IN JEWELL. THESE BIRDS WERE WITH 2 EASTERN BLUEBIRDS ALONG THE LEFT FORK OF THE PARK ROAD. ALSO, AN EARLY COMMON
