SAME LOCATIONS SEVERAL TIMES SINCE INCLUDING ^{THURS} SEPT. 14 THE LOCATION IS ^{ALONG COUNTY V-56} 2 1/2

MILES SOUTH OF BLAIRSTOWN ~~AT~~ 1/2 MILE NORTH OF THE IOWA COUNTY LINE, AROUND A LARGE

BARE FEEDLOT ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE ROAD.

IT HAS BEEN SEEN ^{ON FENCEPOSTS, UTILITY POLES, AROUND THE FEEDLOT} IN A LONE DEAD TREE ABOUT

1/2 MILE EAST OF THE FEEDLOT. THIS BIRD IS

NATIVE TO THE DESERT SOUTHWEST AND HAS NOT BEEN

SEEN IN THE STATE IN MODERN TIMES. HOWEVER,

HARRIS' HAWK IS A FAVORITE OF LICENSED

FALCONERS, SO IT IS POSSIBLE THIS BIRD IS

~~UNCOUNTABLE. IT IS NEVERTHELESS A BEAUTIFUL~~
