

THE HIGHLIGHTS THIS WEEK INCLUDE BRANT +
BARROW'S GOLDENEYE AT DE SOTO NWR, CLAUSON +
THAYER'S GEESES AT SEVERAL LOCATIONS, AND A
FERRUGINOUS HAWK AT RED ROCK.

ON MONDAY JAN 2, A BRANT AND A MALE
BARROW'S GOLDENEYE WERE SEEN FROM THE
VISITOR'S CENTER AT DE SOTO NWR IN
MARION CO IN EXTREME WESTERN IOWA.
BOTH HAVE BEEN SEEN OFF AND ON FOR SEVERAL
WEEKS. THE GOLDENEYE IS PROBABLY THERE ALL
OF THE TIME, BUT THE BRANT IS MOST LIKELY
MID DAY AND AFTERNOON AFTER THE 200,000
SNOW GEESSE RETURNED FROM FEEDING. THERE ARE
ALSO ROSS'S GEESE AND A SW CREST OWL IN
THE PINES AT THE WILSON ISLANDS AREA.

IN CENTRAL IOWA, ON JAN 2, A FERRUGINOUS
HAWK WAS DISCOVERED AT RED ROCK LAKE
IN MARION COUNTY. THE BIRD WAS SEEN IN A
FIELD ALONG THE ROAD TO THE BOAT SAFETY
AREA OF SOUTH ECK ROCK S.P. 2 MILES EAST OF HIGHWAY
Hwy 14 JUST BEFORE THE WHITEBREAST BOTTOMLAND.
ALSO AT RED ROCK A NORTHERN SHRIKE AND
BELLOW THE DAM A TUNDRA SWAN AND SEVERAL
SPECIES OF DUCKS

AT SPYLVILLE RESERVOIR NORTH OF DES MOINES ON

DEC 30TH, 1 GIPSONS & I THOUGHTS AND
A SPW WHET OWL AT ITS USUAL LOCATION IN
CEDARS NORTH OF THE END OF 100TH ST AT BIG
CREEK STATE PARK. ON THE 31ST AN OLD GAG
ON THE LAKE ABOVE THE SAYLORVILLE AREA, BUT IT
WAS FROZEN ON 1/1 AND IT WAS COLD.

AND IN THE AREA ALONG HIGHWAY 415 BETWEEN
SAYLORVILLE & BIG CREEK S-P A GOSHAWK
& A RED SHOULDRED HAWK ON THE 2ND
AND AT GLENDALE CEMETERY IN DES
MOINES 3 WHITE-WINGED CROSSBILLS ON
THE 1ST

OTHER THAN A REPORT OF A FLOCK OF CANADA
GEES WINTERING IN THE IOWA CITY AREA, THERE
WERE NO REPORTS RECEIVED THIS WEEK. THE
FOLLOWING, THEN, ARE THE PERSONAL SIGHTINGS OF
THE BIRDLINE. ON DEC 29, THE ^{IMMATURE} SANDHILL
CRANE FIRST REPORTED SEVERAL WEEKS AGO WAS
STILL PRESENT AT THE GAME BREEDERS FARM IN
POLK CO. TO LOOK FOR THIS BIRD TAKE HIGHWAY 415
NW OF POLK CITY TO A POINT $\frac{1}{2}$ MILE BEYOND
THE BIG CREEK SHOOTING RANGE, THEN GO $\frac{3}{4}$ WEST
ON A GRAVEL ROAD AND GO NORTH ON A LAKE
BY A RUSTIC MAILBOX, ASK PERMISSION TO WALK
THE WATERFOWL ALONGST THE SMALL POND.

ISLAND PARK. AT ENCHANTED ISLAND ON THE 1ST
2 BLACK SCOTERS AND ON THE 2ND AN ADULT
