@ Polk City wildlife Area a yellow-crowned n. heron on the Eleventh @ Saylorville Res, Sandpiper area 30 caspian terns, common terns & dunlins were seen May 13 @ Big Wall lk in Wright City 4-crowned nightheron, b/c nightheron, common moorhen & Am Bittern.

In SE IA in Lee Cty S of Donnelson across from Hwy from Ctrl of Lee Highschool a Hudsonian Godwit @ Cone Marsh in Lousa Cty on the 11th on the 12th Kingbird & Sora rails a black-throated blue warbler, @ Wildcat Den State Park on the 13th 32 species of warbler incl. Connecticut

Near South Arnana in IA ^{County} Cty an Upland Sandpiper on the 14th.

And on the 12th 142 species incl 24 warblers (incl hooded warbler) @ the Arnana woods and Short eared owl @ the Coralville Pts

In new reports, on ~~Monday~~ May 16 in N. CENTRAL IOWA. An observer saw 20 warbler species in Hancock County at McIntosh Woods and Eagle Lake, including several Canada & Mourning Warblers. Three Dunlins at Clear Lake, and at a little marsh east of Spirit Lake in Dickinson Co.; numerous Shorebirds, including Hudsonian Godwit & White Rumped Sandpiper.

At Walker Lake, just east of Fairfield in Jefferson County, Common Moorhen and Least Bittern in the marshy east end on the 17th.

And at Swan Lake in Johnson County, Common Willet, & Dowitchers on the 18th.

And from Ames Orioles at a Hummingbird feeder, which make sense since the birdline has numerous birds at its Oriole feeder.

→ In SW Iowa, ^{ON THE 18TH} 2 Least Terns & 1 piping plover at IXL power s' of Laramie Bluffs, Chuck-wills-widow in usual location near Wabonni sp & blue Grosbeaks in river bottoms w or Wabonni. Little wonder no ~~that~~-did see Hudsonian Godwit @ Ruettger in Fremont County
