AT WATERWORKS PARK IN FAIRFIELD, JEFFERSON COUNTY 8 WARBLER SPECIES INCLUDING GOLDEN WINGED ON THE 10TH & AT JEFFERSON COUNTY PARK NEAR FAIRFIELD ON THE 11TH, LARK & CLAY-COLORED SPARROWS & BELL'S VIREO.

IN NORTHEAST IOWA AT PLEASANT CREEK LAKE STATE PARK ^{IN LINN COUNTY} NORTH OF PALO, A RED NECKED CREEPEE, BLACK & FORSTER'S TERNS ON THE 6TH & 7TH. AT SWEET MARSH IN BREWER COUNTY 10 VIREOS, RAILS & 20 SORA'S ON THE 7TH & A PINE WARBLER AT PIKE'S PEAK S.P. IN ALLAMAKEE COUNTY ON THE 7TH.

IN NORTHWEST IOWA, A SPOTTED TOWHEE ~~IN CLAY COUNTY~~ & 9 BLUE GRAY GNATCATCHERS IN CLAY COUNTY ON THE 8TH. AT MILL CREEK S.P. IN O'BRIEN COUNTY A COMMON LOON AND SHOREBIRDS AT THE NORTH END INCLUDING STILT, HODSONIAN GODWIT, SHORT-BILLED DOWITCHER, LESSER GOLDEN PLOVER, AND BLACK CROWNED NIGHT HERON ON THE 7TH.

ALL 5 RAIL SPECIES AT ONE PLACE DURING A WEEK IS MOST UNUSUAL IN IOWA, BUT IT HAPPENED IN SOUTHEAST IOWA AT CONE MARSH IN LOMAX COUNTY LAST WEEK. ALL WERE SEEN ALONG THE EAST WEST DIKE EXCEPT THE YELLOW WHICH WAS FLUSHED FROM THE FIELD DIRECTLY SOUTH OF THE PARKING LOT FOR THE EAST-WEST DIKE ON SUNDAY MAY 7TH. THE KILL & VIRGINIA RAILS WERE ABUNDANT ALL WEEK, THE KING RAIL WAS SEEN SEVERAL TIMES, THE LAST ON THE 6TH AND THE BLACK RAIL WAS SEEN NEAR SWANBURN ON THE 3RD. IN ADDITION THE DRAKE COMMON TEAL WAS STILL PRESENT ON THE 7TH SOUTH OF THE SOUTH ROAD IN THE MOST WESTERLY WATER. ALSO SEEN FROM THE EAST-WEST DIKE ON THE 7TH WERE AMERICAN & LEAST BITTERNS AND BLACK-CROWN NIGHT HERONS. OTHER BIRDS SEEN AT CONE MARSH THIS PAST WEEK, BAIRD'S SANDPIPER, BUFFLEHEAD, DUNLIN, SHORT BILLED DOWITCHER, AND COMMON MOORHENS TO REACH THIS AREA GO SOUTH FROM THE SCHOOL AT LONE TREE 6 MILES ON COUNTY ROAD X-14, AND WHERE IT TURNS AT A RIGHT ANGLE TO THE EAST GO EAST ON THE GRAVEL 1 MILE, THEN TURN DOWN THE ACES LANE OPPOSITE A YELLOW HOUSE. IN AN UPDATE, ON THE 9TH KING, VA- & SAW RAILS, BOTH BITTERNS & THE TEAL WERE STILL PRESENT.

IN OTHER SOUTHEAST IOWA REPORTS, 139 SPECIES WERE SEEN FROM PEORIA TO IOWA CITY ON THE 7TH INCLUDING 20 WARbler SPECIES, 51 GREAT EGRETS, UPLAND SANDPIPER ON THE JEFFERSON-MUSCATINE COUNTY LINE ROAD AND 2 PAIR OF GRAY PARTRIDGES IN JEFFERSON CO.
