In JOHNSON COUNTY TOOK A BIRD EAGLE AT THE WEST OVERLOOK OF THE CORNVILLE RESERVOIR AND AT JONA CITY'S NICKORY HILL A NORTHERN SPRIKE AND A SAW WHET OWL

AT CREDIT ISLAND IN DRAVEN PORT, A CALIFORNIA GULL WAS DISCOVERED AMONG THE SEVERAL THOUSAND GULLS IN THE AREA. IT WAS LOCATED ON THE MARSH BETWEEN THE CREDIT ISLAND AND THE MAINLAND.
