In Northwest Iowa, 12 WHITE-WINGED CASSIUS AND SOUTH OF RATHBURN IN PACE ACT COAST, 1 TUNDRA SWAN AND 1 SANDHILL CRANE AT BIG SPIRIT LAKE IN DICKINSON COUNTY, 3 BALD EAGLES ON THE EAST SIDE OF TRUMBULL LAKE, AND A PRAIRIE FALCON AT WEST SPENCER IN CLAY COUNTY, ALL REPORTS FROM THE 18TH.

THE ONLY BIRDS MOST OF YOU LOOKED AT TODAY WERE TURKEYS. In another news report, CLADY'S BLACK REPORTED AN IMMATURE TRUMPETER SWAN ^{IN WISCONSIN COUNTY} AT THE DAVIS FARM WEST OF PROMISE CITY, AND AT THE RAVENSCOE WILDLIFE AREA IN POLK COUNTY 75,000 DUCKS AND 7 BALD EAGLES. In JEFFERSON COUNTY TODAY A BALD EAGLE AT THE WEST OVERLOOK OF THE CORACVILLE RESERVOIR AND AT IOWA CITY'S HICKORY HILL A NORTHERN SHRIKE AND A SAW WHET OWL.

AT CREDIT ISLAND IN DRAVENPORT, A CAROLINA GULL WAS DISCOVERED AMONG THE SEVERAL THOUSAND GULLS IN THE AREA. IT WAS LOCATED ON THE HARBOR BETWEEN THE CREDIT ISLAND AND THE MAINLAND.
