In the southeast in Lee County, a winter male OLDSQUAW was on pool #19 of the Mississippi River north of Keokuk at Sandusky on the 1rst, and an adult PEREGRINE FALCON was seen chasing pigeons in downtown Keokuk on the 27th. The EURASIAN TREE SPARROWS are still being seen north of Burlington, and you can call Chuck Fuller for more information art (319)753-0710. In Johnson County, the adult LESSER BLACK-BACKED GULL first discovered at the Coralville Reservoir on the 24th at the Jolly Roger area, was relocated on the 28th out from the parking lot along county road F-20 near the Hawkeye Wildlife Area headquarters.

In the northeast in Linn County. a WHITE-WINGED SCOTER and COMMON LOON were with other more common diving ducks, including a female REDHEAD, at Pleasant Creek Lake State Park four miles north of Palo on the 27th.

In the south-central at Red Rock Reservoir in Marion County, an adult MUTE SWAN was on the north side of the lake just above the dam, and the second winter THAYER'S GULL was still being seen below the dam on the 28th. On the 27th, four other gull species were with the THAYER'S below the dam, including a FRANKLIN'S and six BONAPARTE'S, and in addition an immature TUNDRA SWAN. Also on the 27th, an OLDSQUAW and several WHITE-WINGED SCOTERS were seen on the lake just east of Whitebreast Point.

In the northwest in Sioux County on the 27th, a NORTHERN SAW WHET OWL was found at Oak Grove County Park, and a MERLIN was spotted two miles north of Hawarden.
