Most of my time is spent on Purple Martins and Eastern Bluebirds during this period.

The hot weather during late June and early July was hard on nesting here.

The following report is just on the nesting species, I have seen some change from last year.

Ruby-thr. Hummingbird- This was first year adult male seen almost everyday during nesting period.

Great Crested Flycatchers-Numbers down.

Purple Martin-I had reports from 8 Colonies in this area. ~~Less~~
TOTAL nesting birds than last year. My colony was the only one with a small increase to 33 Pair.

Tufted Titmouse-Sightings up.

Wood Thrush-More singing Males heard than in past at my place.

Eastern Bluebird-After two bad years, they are making a recovery, with numbers double the past two Summers.

Eastern Meadowlark-Singing males down.

Orchard Oriole-Sightings up.
