This is the Iowa Birdline with news of KING RAILS and the passerine migration is certainly underway, and should continue to accelerate the next few weeks.

In the southeast, on the 16th, Jim Scheib and Daniel and Randy Pinkston observed five KING RAILS, a SORA, LEAST BITTERN, eight shorebird species, including BLACK-BELLIED PLOVER, and two CASPIAN TERNS at Casey-Barrow Public Landing on the Mississippi River ten miles north of Burlington, and Chuck Fuller had four AMERICAN AVOCETS at the same location on the 11th. In Lee County, along the Des Moines River Road between the Croton Unit of Shimek State Forest and the village of Croton, Pete Wickham saw a pair of BLUE GROSBEAKS and a CAROLINA WREN 0.9 miles northwest of the Turkey Run Access. Also along the road a little farther east was a singing SEDGE WREN, all on the 16th.

In the central, Mark Proescholdt reports seven warbler species, including CANADA and GOLDEN-WINGED, plus YELLOW BELLIED FLYCATCHER at Grammer Grove Park in Marshall County on the 16th.

In the northwest, Matt Kenne saw six warbler species, plus a YELLOW BELLIED FLYCATCHER at Ambrose Call State Park near Algona over the past weekend.

In the northeast, Dennis Carter had OLIVE-SIDED FLYCATCHERS, several warbler species, and an adult BALD EAGLE at Effigy Mounds National Monument in Allamakee County on the 15th, and at Squaw Creek Park near Cedar Rapids, Pete Wickham spotted an OLIVE-SIDED FLYCATCHER on the 13th.

In the north-central, one WESTERN GREBE was seen on Silver Lake in Worth County by Tom Kent on the 14th.
