The highlight of the week was a SABINE'S GULL in Linn County.

In the northeast, Pete Wickham discovered a first year SABINE'S GULL at Pleasant Creek Lake State Park north of Palo in Linn County on the 1rst. Unfortunately, the bird departed in the company of twenty RING-BILLED GULLS, and was not seen again. On the 1rst at Cardinal Marsh in Winneshiek County, sparrows were abundant, and included FOX and HARRIS', and there was also a late MAGNOLIA WARBLER. At Cedar Rapids, an AMERICAN BITTERN was spotted flyinh around Cedar Lake the evening of the 1rst.

In the northwest, a SHORT-EARED OWL was seen near the Woodbury-Ida County line on the 3rd. For more information, call Pete Ernzen at (712)364-2183 (Home) or (712)364-3300 (Work).

In the southeast. raptors, especially accipiters, were reported to be moving through the Iowa City area on the 3rd, and included an immature NORTHERN GOSHAWK, as well as a MERLIN.
