This week's highlight is an adult MEW GULL in Marion County, which was discovered by Tim Schantz on a gravel bar below the Red Rock Reservoir Dam. The bird was found late in the day on the 12th, and despite considerable searching was not relocated the next day. This would be a second state record, and it should be pointed out that the gravel bar where it was found has produced five previous first state record gulls, most recently the ROSS' GULL on October 31. There was also a first-year THAYER'S GULL at that location on the 13th. Elsewhere in the Red Rock area, four AMERICAN PIPITS were at the north end of Roberts Creek Lake on the 13th, and five COMMON LOONS, two HOODED MERGANSERS, and a LOGGERHEAD SHRIKE were seen at Whitebreast Point on the 11th. Elsewhere in the south-central at Lake Rathbun in Appanoose County, the SNOWY OWL was quite regular all last week either on a rocky spit or in the campground, both of which are west of Dedication Point in the Island View Recreation Area south of the dam. On the 14th it was reported from the campground. A HORNED GREBE and FRANKLIN'S GULL were seen from the campground on the 11th. In Monroe County, the SNOWY OWL which had been near the intersection of county roads S-65 and H-20 for a week was found dead on the 11th.

In the northeast in Clayton County, the male WHITE-WINGED CROSSBILL was still visiting an Elkader feeder on the 13th, but the EVENING GROSBEAKS were last seen at Larry Stone's feeder near Elkader on the 9th. For more information, you

In Allamakee County, 500 TUNDRA SWANS were on pool #9 of the Mississippi River above the dam at Harper's Ferry, and a GOLDEN EAGLE was over the Upper Iowa River bluffs along county road A-26 southwest of New Albin, both reports from the 13th. In Linn County, a female BLACK SCOTER, an immature male WHITE-WIMGED SCOTER, GREATER SCAUP, and five COMMON LOONS were at Pleasant Creek state Recreation Area north of Palo on the 14th. Jim and Joyce Durbin report a very late NORTHERN ORIOLE in their yard in Marion on the 12th. A partial albino RED-TAILED HAWK was along hiway #1 south of Mt. Vernon on the 12th. In Jones County, a dead NORTHERN SAW-WHET OWL was found southwest of Anamosa near Wapsipinicon State Park on the 12th.

In the southwest, a SNOWY OWL was seen on the 11th for the fifth straight day in Fremont County a mile east of Farragut. For more information, call Barbara Cunningham at (712) 246-1203.

In the northwest in Buena Vista County, a SNOWY OWL was along county road C-49, six and three/quarter miles east of Storm Lake on the 13th. In Palo Alto County, an immature of County NORTHERN GOSHAWK was at Houston Park on Lost Island Lake, a NORTHERN SHRIKE and a flock of a thousand RUSTY BLACKBIRDS were at TRUMBULL Lake, and in DICKINSON COUNTY a HORNED GREBE was off Marble Beach at Big Spirit Lake, all on the 11th. In Cherokee County, a RED-BELLIED WOODPECKER, unusual that far northwest, has been at Hetty Engdahl's feeder in Aurelia for the past two weeks.

In the west in Monona County, a WHITE-WINGED SCOTER and a ROSS' GOOSE were at Blue Lake, which is reached from hiway 175 west of I-29, on the 11th.

In the central, in Madsion County, a SNOWY OWL was seen three miles west of Badger Creek Lake on the 12th. In Jasper County, a female BLACK SCOTER, HORNED GREBE, and COMMON LOON were at Rock Crek Lake State Park on the 13th. In Marshall County, three CATTLE EGRETS were still at the quarry along East Main Street, just east of Marshalltown on the 13th, and the male EVENING GROSBEAK at Betty Savage's feeder in Marshalltown was last seen on the 9th.
