It's not too early to look for migrant warblers. Tonight, in just a few minutes in my back yard, I saw black and white and blackburnian warblers and Philadelphia vireo.

And we received the third report in the past several months of a possible black vulture, ~~this one~~ in eastern Iowa, the one from the Davenport area at the Lindsey marina. Look ~~these three~~ ~~vultures~~ over. If any of the turkey vultures you see are watching have white wing ends, short black head and short tail, think black vulture. And now is the time to look over those hummingbirds at your feeder for odd ones, especially rufous.
