

(7) ON THE 6TH IN THE CENTRAL, RANDY PINKSTON REPORTS A FIRST WINTER CALIFORNIA GULL AT THE SAYLORVILLE RESERVOIR NORTH OF DEL MONTE. THE BIRD WAS WITH SEVERAL HUNDRED RING-BILLED AND HERRING GULLS BOTH ABOVE AND BELOW THE DAM ON THE AFTERNOON.

In the northeast in Linn County at Pleasant Creek State Recreation Area north of Palo, there were 15 species of waterfowl on the 4th, which included two female BLACK SCOTERS, a male WHITE-WINGED SCOTER, three OLDSQUAWS, a TUNDRA SWAN, and a TRUMPETER SWAN.

A MERLIN was seen about one mile north of the Cedar Rapids airport on the 4th. In Bremer County, a SNOWY OWL was seen several times through the middle of last week two miles north of Bremer, which is located at the intersection of county roads C-33 and V-21.

In the southeast, the SNOWY OWL southwest of Iowa City was not seen again after its initial sighting on the 2nd. In Van Buren County, a gray phase EASTERN SCREECH OWL was observed in a wood duck house along the Des Moines River road just east of Bonaparte on the 5th. In Des Moines County, about fifty EURASIAN TREE SPARROWS were around the intersection of Tama Road and a gravel road which is about two and a half miles northeast of hiway 99. Tama Road exits east off of hiway 99 about a mile north of Burlington.
