In Van Buren County, a gray phase EASTERN SCREECH OWL was observed in a wood duck house along the Des Moines River road just east of Bonaparte on the 5th. In Des Moines County, about fifty EURASIAN TREE SPARROWS were around the intersection of Tama Road and a gravel road which is about two and a half miles northeast of hiway 99. Tama Road exits east off of hiway 99 about a mile north of Burlington.
