The best birds this week are TOWNSEND'S SOLITAIRE, GREAT BLACK-BACKED GULL, and SHORT-EARED OWL. In the north-central, the two TOWNSEND'S SOLITAIRES could still be found in the Shell Rock River greenbelt in Cerro Gordo County as of the 28th. To look for these birds, go south from Rock Falls on county road S-62 for a mile, and then east on 295th Street for a mile and a half. Park just west of a cement bridge, and walk south 200-250 yards. There was also a large flock of HORNED LARKS, LAPLAND LONGSPURS, and SNOW BUNTINGS near the intersection of S-62 and 295th Street on the 28th. For updates, call Kurt Nelson at (515)696-5600.

In the southeast in Scott County, along the Mississippi River, a first winter GREAT BLACK-BACKED GULL was seen from the duck feeding area along the Butterworth Parkway in Moline on the 28th. In Muscatine County, a CAROLINA WREN was at the first parking lot at Red Cedar Woods on the 27th. At Cone Marsh in Louisa County on the 28th, there were three SWAMP SPARROWS, and just north of there along county road G-28, 0.8 miles east of T Street there was a flock of HORNED LARKS, SNOW BUNTINGS, and LAPLAND LONGSPURS.

In the northeast in Linn County, up to three SHORT-EARED OWLS were present on the 26th and 27th just north of the Cedar Rapids airport, along 76th Avenue, a quarter mile west of Edgewood Road. There are also large numbers of SNOW BUNTINGS and LAPLAND LONGSPURS, and quite a few GRAY PARTRIDGE in the area, especially along Edgewood Road. The adult NORTHERN GOSHAWK was still being seen at the Cedar Rapids Nursery, 2100 Wilson Avenue on the 24th.
