IN NEW REPORTS, IN IOWA COUNTY, A NORTHERN SAW WHET OWL WAS IN PINE TREES ACROSS FROM THE DEPOT AT MOORHEAD PARK. ON THE 29<sup>TH</sup> IN IOWA COUNTY, A FIRST YEAR GLAUCOUS GULL WAS ON THE MISSISSIPPI NEAR THE AMTRAK STATION AT FORT MADISON ON THE 27<sup>TH</sup> AND AT CEDAR LAKE IN CEDAR RAPIDS, AMONG THE THOUSANDS OF MARRAS AND CANADA GESE ON THE 24<sup>TH</sup> WERE 2 WOOD DUCKS, TWO AMERICAN COTS, 3 BLACK DUCKS, AND A RED BLUED GRAY. AND IN AN UPDATE, THE OLD MOUND WAS STILL PRESENT BELOW THE RED ROCK RESERVOIR DAM BETWEEN THE FOOT BRIDGE AND THE OLD IRON BRIDGE ON THE 29<sup>TH</sup>.

NEW NEWS FROM THE 30<sup>TH</sup> INCLUDED UPDATES OF THE ICELAND GULL AT IOWA CITY, THE SAW WHET OWL IN JOHNSON COUNTY, AND THE TRUMPETER SWAN AT CEDAR RAPIDS <sup>WHICH</sup> WERE ALL SEEN AGAIN TODAY. IN NEW REPORTS, AT CEDAR RAPIDS, THE ADULT NORTHERN GOSHAWK WAS RELOCATED AT THE WEST SIDE OF THE CEDAR RAPIDS UNIVERSITY, 2100 WILSON AVENUE, ~~AND~~ <sup>IN JOHNSON COUNTY</sup> AT THE CORNWALL RESERVOIR A LONG EARED OWL AND A NORTHERN SKINK WERE FOUND ABOUT A QUARTER MILE SOUTHWEST OF THE INTERSECTION OF THE GREENCASTLE AND SWAN LAKE ROAD, AND IN THE WEST, GERTRUDE JACOBSEN OF BLESSIE IN MONONA COUNTY REPORTED A PEREGRINE FALCON VISITED HER YARD ON THE 29<sup>TH</sup>.

Even though we don't mention it every week, the EURASIAN TREE SPARROWS seem to be established in the Burlington area. They been seen from several miles south of town to ten miles north of town, as well as directly across the Mississippi in Illinois. The center of the population is about three miles north of Burlington along Tama Road. For more details, call Chuck Fuller at (319)753-0710. The week's best birds remain the same as last week; TOWNSEND'S SOLITAIRE, OLDSQUAW, and TRUMPETER SWAN.

In the north-central, the two TOWNSEND'S SOLITAIRES were still being seen in Cerro Gordo County on the 24th. From Rock Falls, go south on county road S-62 for one mile, and then east on 295th Street a mile and a half. Park just west of a cement bridge, walk south 200 yards, and look in cedar trees. Also seen in the area on the 24th were four YELLOW-RUMPED WARBLERS, a NORTHERN SHRIKE, and a NORTHERN GOSHAWK. For updates, call Kurt Nelson at (515)696-5600.

In the south-central in Marion County, the OLDSQUAW was still below the Red Rock Reservoir dam, but there were no gulls there on the 23rd. GLAUCOUS and THAYER'S had been present on the 19th.

In the northeast in Linn County, the two TRUMPETER SWANS were still on the Cedar River along Old River Road in the south part of Cedar Rapids on the 22nd, a flock of SNOW BUNTINGS was in a field at the south end of Edgewood Road near the Cedar Rapids airport on the 24th, and at Robins, the RED-SHOULDERED HAWK has not been seen now since the 13th.

In the southeast in Iowa County. a LONG-EARED OWL, five NORTHERN SAW-WHET OWLS, an albino GREAT-HORNED OWL, and a GRAY CATBIRD were at the Amana Woods, in the old ice pond area, which is on the north side of hiway #6 a half mile west of Homestead on the 24th. In Johnson County, the gull flock on the Iowa River at Iowa City near Hancher Auditorium included first year ICELAND and THAYER'S on the 19th, but only the THAYER'S was seen on the 24th. The GOLDEN-CROWNED KINGLETS were still in pine trees on the west side of the Hancher parking lot on the 24th. A red-phase SCREECH OWL was at Hickory Hill Park on the 21st, in a cedar tree down the hill east of the parking lot for the Dodge Street entrance. A NORTHERN-SAW-WHET OWL was still being found in cedars on the north side of county road F-20, 0.7 miles west of the Hawkeye Wildlife Area headquarters on the 22nd, and a NORTHERN GOSHAWK was there on the 19th.

In the central in Polk County, a MERLIN was along the south side of Dale Moffett Reservoir on the 23rd, two EASTERN BLUEBIRDS were three miles north of Van Meter in Dallas County on the 23rd, and a CAROLINA WREN was just north of Ledges State Park in Boone County on the 23rd.
