ON THE 13<sup>TH</sup>, TIM SCHWARTZ REPORTED AN ADULT ICELAND GULL IN A FIELD WITH ABOUT 300 RING BILLED GULLS, ABOUT 7 PM. TAKE THE MITCHELLVILLE EXIT FROM I-80 AND GO NORTH TO THE FIRST GRAVEL ROAD EAST, WHICH IS 12<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE WEST. FOLLOW IT A MILE AND A HALF AND THE GULLS WERE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE ROAD NEAR WHERE 140 ST SOUTH INTERSECTS.

Iowa Birdline (319)338-9881 for 4/12/93  
Widely reported migrants this past week were COMMON LOON and WINTER WREN. Some of the new arrivals included BARN and ROUGH-WINGED SWALLOWS, BROWN THRASHER, SORA, YELLOW-HEADED BLACKBIRD, and several species of shorebirds. The best birds are IBIS (Sp.) in the southwest, SANDHILL CRANES in Tama County, CINNAMON TEAL in GUTHRIE COUNTY, and the BLACK-THROATED SPARROW at Waterloo. We have had no further news of the PRARIE FALCON in Clay County.

In the southwest at Forney Lake in Fremont County on the 9th, an immature GOLDEN EAGLE was observed to flush thirteen IBIS (Sp.), which then settled back down in the northwest part of the lake. For more information, call Ross Silcock at (712)629-5865.

In the northeast, the BLACK-THROATED SPARROW was still at Waterloo, at least through the 7th. Since March 14, this first state record has been at the feeder of Maurice and Ruby Hanson, 1262 Ackermant. You can reach the Hansons at (319)233-2457. In Bremer County on the 8th, 65 TUNDRA SWANS were at the Aldo Leopold wetland complex, which is adjacent to the Wapsi Valley School about six miles southeast of Readlyn. In Linn County at Pleasant Creek State Recreation Area, four HORNEED GREBES were seen on the 10th.

In the central in Guthrie County, at Lakin Slough, a drake CINNAMON TEAL was still present on the 10th. It was last seen by walking in from the south parking lot and looking to the east beyond the second grove of trees. On the 11th, there were 19 WHITE-FRONTED GEESE at Lakin. At Bay's Branch, HORNEED GREBES and WHITE PELICANS were present on the 10th. In Tama County, six SANDHILL CRANES, two SORAS, and a PILEATED WOODPECKER were seen at Otter Creek Marsh on the 10th. In Polk County, two BLACK-CROWNED NIGHT HERONS were at Brenton Slough on the 9th. In Franklin County, twenty HUDSONIAN GODWITS were in a flooded field east of Radford on the 10th. In Jasper County, three HORNEED GREBES were at Rock Creek Lake State Park on the 7th.

In the southeast in Johnson County, two EARED GREBES and a HORNEED GREBE were at Swan Lake on the 11th.
