The cloud-blocked light during the half hour before sunset and long range precluded any real diagnosis of bill or foot color, although the bill of one was discernibly dark compared to the still discernibly yellow bills of the Greats; long, very slender necks, proportionately long bills—not Cattle Egrets).
