>Jodeane Cancilla (McBride Raptor Project) is leaving for U. of MN. Raptor
>Center Thursday morn. She's bringing nine osprey. Four will be placed at
>10AM Friday, 7/14, at McBride and five at 6PM at Hartman Reserve Nature
>Center of Black Hawk CCB. There is a possibility, high water may force a
>change from Hartman to Saylorville, then it will be 6PM at Saylorville.
>As it stands now high water at Hartman Reserve will not affect the hack
>and the forecast is good.
>
>Saylorville placement is scheduled for 10AM Wednesday, July 19. Joe
>Boyles (Polk CCB) and Heather Freidhof (Boone CCB) will be in Brainerd,
>MN. on July 18 to get osprey.
>
>Birds will be in hack towers for approximately one week to 10 days then
>released. Care will be provided by respective organizations and volunteers.
>Project is collaborative effort that includes McBride Raptor Project,
>Black hawk, Boone, and Polk CCB, IA DNR, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and
>75+ volunteers. Osprey are viewed as sentinels of clean water efforts.
