			<b>NOTE:</b> there was a lot of staining on 2 of these adults (still with red crown visible) and they were feeding just next to a small cattle feedlot. The third bird flew overhead and flew back further into the marsh.

			<b>NOTE:</b> Both of these birds were calling near the "walk-in" campground.	
<b>Chestnut-sided Warbler</b>	1	1 June	Lee Co.-Shimek Forest - Donnellson Unit	P & R Allen
			<b>NOTE:</b> late migrant? or nester? Alternate-plumaged male.	
<b>Yellow-breasted Chat</b>	1	7 June	Johnson Co. - Lake McBride - near sailboat storage area.	P & R Allen
