Green-winged Teal: male at Cardinal M. on 13 Jun.

Solitary Sandpiper: one at Mill Creek State Park on 27 Jun.

Upland Sandpiper: one in Cherokee Co. on 16 Jun, 2 in Clay Co. on 20 Jun.

Olive-sided Flycatcher: one at Mill Creek State Park on 7 Jun. Eastern Phoebe: nest with two young in O'Brien Co. on 17 Jul.

Loggerhead Shrike: one in Kossuth Co. on 13 Jun; 4 in Plymouth Co. on 21 Jul.

White-eyed Vireo: one on 14 Jun at Coon Creek W.A., Winneshiek Co.

Red-breasted Nuthatch: one in Yellow River Forest on 15 Jun. "Lawrence's" Warbler: one in Yellow River Forest on 15 Jun.

Chestnut-sided Warbler: 2 males and a female on 14 Jun at Coon Creek W.A. Winneshiek Co.

Blue Grosbeak: a pair at Mill Creek State Park during the period.
