SANDELLERS WERE OBSERVED IN THE DRISCOLL'S
ISLAND AREA ON THE NORTH SIDE OF HIGHWAY 64

CLUDING GOLDEN-WINGED AND 2 BW NEAKERS

MOINES CO ON SEPT 6, 1 SNOWY EGRET, 20
CASPIAN TURNS AND 2 IMMATURE YELLOW
CROWNED NIGHT HERONS. AT THE CORNUVILLE
RESERVOIR IN JOHNSON CO ON THE 10TH JUST
WEST OF HIGHWAY 965, A SANDERLING, STILT
SANDPIPER AND CASPIAN TURNS AND ON
SEPT 13 AT THE TOWN VIEW HEIGHTS AREA
AT THE MOUTH OF NOOTER CREEK, BB PLOVERS,
DOWITCHERS & CASPIAN TURNS
