A NUMBER OF CHRISTMAS BIRD COUNTS WERE HELD THIS PAST WEEKEND AND AS USUAL, SEVERAL GOOD BIRDS WERE DISCOVERED. IN HIGHLIGHTS THIS WEEK 2 SANDHILL CRANES AT 2 NW IOWA LOCATIONS, 5+ CENTRAL IA CULLS ALONG THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER, AND 2 SW WHET OWLS NEAR IOWA CITY.

IN NW IOWA ON DEC 15, 2 SANDHILL CRANES WERE SEEN IN A CORNFIELD EAST OF SPIRIT LAKE IN DICKINSON COUNTY, AND 1 SANDHILL HAS BEEN PRESENT WITH CANADA GEESE FOR SEVERAL WEEKS AT BLACKHAWK LAKE IN SAC COUNTY. AND A NORTHERN SHRIKE WAS BADED EAST WEEK BY RITA BETH OF AUBURN IN SAC COUNTY X

THE DAVENPORT CHRISTMAS COUNT HELD DEC 18 TOTALLED ABOUT 80 SPECIES, HIGHLIGHTED BY AN ADULT GREAT BLACK-BACKED GULL JUST ABOVE L+D #15 IN DOWNTOWN + WAS VIEWED FROM THE DAVENPORT TIMES STOREHOUSE PARKER LOT EAST OF 3RD ST + RIVER DRIVE. 2 GLASS
