ALSO ON NOV 6 A PRAIRIE FALCON WAS OBSERVED IN MARSHALL CO NORTH OF MARSHALL TOWN

IN OUTHRIE CO. AT BAY'S BEACH, AN ALBINO R. W. BLACKBIRD

IN SE IOWA ON NOV 6<sup>TH</sup>, AT THE PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE MISSISSIPPI RIVER 9 MILES NORTH OF BURLINGTON IN DES MOINES CO, 2 WHITE-WINGED SCOTERS, NUMEROUS Gulls, AND A HOODED GREBE, AND AT LAKE LEWIS IN HENRY CO ANOTHER HOODED GREBE. AT MONTROSE IN LEE CO ON POOL #19 APPROXIMATELY 8<sup>000</sup> M WATERFOWL ARE NOW PRESENT WITH 80-90% ESTIMATED TO BE CANVASBACKS
