AT WEST OKOBOJI LAKE IN DICKINSON CO. ~~AND~~  
IOWA 3 WHITE-WINGED <sup>SCOTERS</sup> AND 1 SURF SCOTER WERE SEEN  
ALONG THE SOUTH SHORE AT TERRACE PARK ON DEC. 3+4.  
ALSO AT W. OKOBOJI THIS PAST WEEKEND 6 BALD EAGLES  
AND AN IMMATURE TUNDRA SWAN AT MILLER'S BAY. FOR

ALSO IN NW IOWA ON DEC 1<sup>ST</sup> A SNOWY OWL  
WAS REPORTED 1/2 MILE SOUTH OF HAUFLOCK IN  
POCAHONTAS CO. AND LONG AND SHORT-EARED OWLS  
IN THE RUSH LAKE AREA IN PALO ALTO COUNTY, APPROX-  
IMATELY 6 MILES NORTH OF LAURENS.

IN CENTRAL IOWA AT SAYLORVILLE LAKE IN POLK CO  
2 GLAUCOUS GULLS AND AT LEAST 1 FIRST YEAR  
THAYER'S GULL WERE FOUND DEC 3 AT THE JESTER  
PARK AREA. THE HUNDREDS OF GULLS CAN BE  
SCOPED BEST FROM ~~THE~~ CAMPING AREA #4 AT  
JESTER PARK. AND NEAR THE END OF <sup>THE</sup> RIGHT HAND ROAD  
OF THE T AT THE ENDS OF 146<sup>TH</sup> ST AT BIG CREEK ST  
2 LONG EARED OWLS ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup>. AND THE R.S HAWK  
WHICH WAS PRESENT EARLIER WAS OBSERVED OVER THE  
WEEKEND BETWEEN SANDPIPER REC AREA + POLK CITY

RETURNED ON DEC 5<sup>TH</sup>.

ROAD T-15 N. OF THE RED ROCK DAM.

PRESENT ON NOV 29 AT THE WEST OVERLOOK OF  
THE CORACVILLE RESERVOIR IN JOHNSON CO, BUT HAS NOT
