IN SE IOWA AT THE CORAVILLE RES IN
JOHNSON CO. ON THE 29TH A FEMALE SURF SCOTER AND ON
THE 27TH 2 CORONARS, 2
BALD EAGLES, 5 BONAPARTE'S GULLS, AND A
COMMON LOON AND AT LAKE MACBRIDE, HOOSES
MELLANERS AND A NORTHERN GAGGLE. WHILE AT
~~HOLMES~~ IOWA CITY'S NICKERTON HILL PARK A
SAW WHET OWL ON THE 27TH.

AS LONG AS THE LAKES AND PONDS REMAIN UNFROZEN,
GOOD WATER ASSOCIATED BIRDS CONTINUE TO BE REPORTED.
ON FRIDAY, NOV. 25, A FIRST WINTER BLACK-LEGGED
KITTIWAKE WAS DISCOVERED AT THE TAKWATER AREA BELOW
THE RED ROCK DAM IN MARION COUNTY. IT WAS SEEN
FLYING AND SITTING WITH RING BILLED GULLS, AND IT
WAS STILL PRESENT ON SUNDAY THE 27TH. AT RED
ROCK LAKE THERE ARE ABOUT 2000 WATERFOWL, MOSTLY
MALLARDS AND AT RATHBURN RESERVOIR IN APPALOOSA
COUNTY 250 CANADA GEESE AND A FEW DUCKS.

AT SAYLORVILLE RESERVOIR IN POLK COUNTY, SEVERAL
GOOD BIRDS CONTINUE TO BE SEEN. THE ROCK
JUNCO AT THE CHERRY GLEN ACCESS FIRST LOCATED
ON THE 8TH WAS STILL BEING SEEN ON THE 25TH.
LOOKING THE ROCKS BETWEEN THE BOAT LAUNCHES
~~LAST WEEK~~ THE LESSER BLACK BACKED GULL WAS SEEN NEAR
THE BIG CREEK SPILLWAY ON THE 21ST AND FROM
THE HIGHWAY #17 BRIDGE ON THE 23RD. AND THE
2-4 OLD SQUAWNS EAST OF THE HIGHWAY #17 BRIDGE
WERE STILL PRESENT ON THE 26TH. IN OTHER
REPORTS FROM SAYLORVILLE-BIG CREEK, 2 SANDHILL
CRANES WERE SEEN FLYING OVER CHERRY GLEN
ON THE 26TH, A FRANKLIN'S GULL IN FULL
BREEDING PLUMAGE, + AND A LATE GREAT BLUE HERON
WERE EAST OF THE HIGHWAY 17 BRIDGE ON THE 23RD
ALSO 3 COMMON LOONS ON SAYLORVILLE LAKE AND
